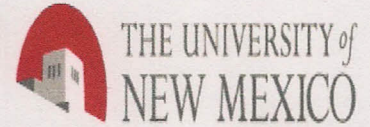

- Must have a financial need for the scholarship

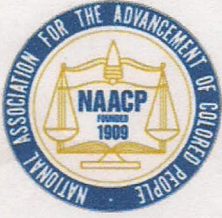

- Academic transcripts of most recent course work

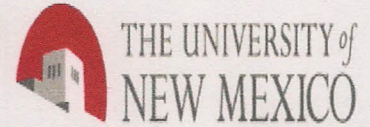
